OPERATIONS

- Contract gravel continues this week in Lawrence Township.
- Roadside mowing continues this week. The contractor has a mower in Antwerp Township finishing up the Southern Townships and a mower working through Pine Grove, Almena, and Arlington Townships. ENGINEERING

- Red Arrow Highway between CR 671 S and the Village of Lawrence in Lawrence and Paw Paw Townships is complete and open to traffic.
- Autumn Vineyards Subdivision in Antwerp Township continues this week with paving after delays from the asphalt plant and weather.
- 30th Street between CR 653 and M-43 in Almena Township continues this week with crushing and shaping the road base.
- A culvert replacement on 30th Avenue between 76th Street and 77.5 Street in Covert Township began this week. The road remains closed to all traffic.

- The Van Buren County Road Commission will be closed July 3rd and 4th in observance of Independence Day. All work, except that of an emergency nature, will be suspended until July 5th. Any road-related emergencies should be reported to 911 during this time.
