### OPERATIONS

- The current break in sub-zero temperatures is allowing our road crew to scrape the existing pad of ice and snow pack from the last few weeks! Although roads may appear bare and dry, please drive with caution and expect black ice at any time.
- A note from our drivers: please be sure to manually turn on your headlights, fully clear your vehicle off before you drive, and NEVER pass a plow on the right! Blowing snow obscures the wing plow and it can create a dangerous situation for drivers. Please give our crews time to clear the roads and space to do so.
