### MAINTENANCE

#### *Operations Update*

- Fog seal operations will begin September 1st in Waverly and Arlington Townships. Daily updates for fog seal are posted on all of our social media channels.
- Blue Star Highway mowing is scheduled to be completed this week.
- Extra width mowing continues in Decatur, Alma, and Waverly Townships.
- The final rounds of dust control are scheduled to be completed by September 10th, pending weather.
- Miscellaneous ditching, storm clean-up, tree trimming and removals to occur as time and weather allow.

### ENGINEERING

#### *Update*

- CR 388 from the Village of Bloomingdale to CR 384 began August 23rd and has an expected completion date of October 15th. The project will be a total reconstruction of the roadbase. The crushing portion of the work is expected to be completed this week.
- Several projects were let for bid. The bids were opened on August 30th and will be awarded at the board meeting on September 1st.
- Burgess Road from 38th Street to 82nd Avenue in Decatur Township is expected to continue next week, pending contractor availability.
