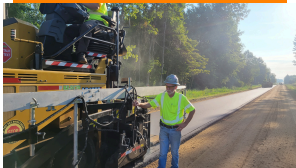
OPERATIONS

- Fog seal will begin next week in Antwerp Township. Daily locations will be posted on our social media channels.
- Pipe replacements and drainage improvements continue at Kable and 48th Avenue in Bangor Township and 88th Avenue in Keeler Township.
- Roadside mowing continues in the Northern Townships of the county. The contractor is expected to wrap up in mid-September.
- Brush spray wrapped up on Monday.
- Gravel roads are being graded in Hamilton, Arlington, and Hartford Townships in preparation for the final dust control application.
- De-berming crews are in Covert Township this week.
- VBCRC's tree crew is prepping 26th Avenue between M-140 and 72nd Street in Covert Township for a drainage and ditching project.

ENGINEERING

- 30th Street between CR 653 and M-43 in Almena Township continues this week with ditching and drainage improvements. Paving is scheduled to occur next week.
- Paving on 16th Avenue between 60th Street and 62nd Street in Geneva Township started this week.
- CR 388 between 29th Street and CR 653 S in Pine Grove Township is scheduled to be reconstructed beginning the week of September 18th.
