

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF APRIL 22

OPERATIONS

- Crews are hot mix patching potholes and road edges across the county on the local and primary road systems while total patchers are focusing on primary roads. Potholes can be reported 24/7 at SeeClickFix.com or using the SeeClickFix app!
- Tree crews are in Antwerp Township on 72nd Avenue between 29th and 26th Streets as well as 66th Avenue between CR 657 and 26th Street.
- The stump grinding crew is finishing up in Pine Grove Township on CR 388 between CR 653 and Kalamazoo County. Next up for this crew are the tree jobs in Antwerp mentioned above.
- Graders are re-shaping gravel roads in Columbia, Geneva, and Pine Grove Townships.
- Trucks are out reclaiming shoulder gravel and repairing shoulder drops in Hamilton, Hartford, Covert, Columbia, and Geneva Townships.

ENGINEERING

- Clearing and drainage work in preparation of paving Howard Drive in Lawrence Township began last week and is expected to be completed by May 31st.
- CR 360 between 55th Street and CR 215 in Hamilton Township continues with a culvert replacement. This project is expected to be completed by April 26th. The road is fully closed to thru-traffic and the detour route follows CR 215, CR 365, and CR 681. For more information, please visit our website vbcrc.org/projects.
