OPERATIONS

- VBCRC continues to sweep intersections this week in Keeler and Covert Townships.
- The crew on 30th Avenue between 75th and 76th Streets in Covert Townships has moved from ditching to installing crosspipes and driveway tubes.
- Boom mowers are still out on local and primary roads county-wide.
- Pothole patching crews are working on the primary road system county-wide.
- De-berming season is upon us! De-berming is utilized to assist in drainage by removing the small berm of soil and vegetation along the road ways that prevent water from flowing off the road. It is also used to clear road edges for better adhesion of various surface treatments. Locations will be posted daily on our social media channels.

ENGINEERING

- Progress on CR 689 between 8th Avenue and CR 388 in South Haven Township will continue as contractor availability allows.
- VBCRC crews are removing trees on CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township and on CR 384 between CR 687 and the South Haven Township line in Geneva Township in preparation of larger projects to occur this construction season.
