

# VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

## FOR THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 4

### OPERATIONS

- The third round of roadside mowing continues in Paw Paw and Bangor Townships with Covert Township up next.
- Graders continue in Bloomingdale and Paw Paw Townships, pending a clear forecast.
- Crews are prepping for winter by patching potholes, trimming trees, and placing shoulder gravel along their plow routes.
- Boom mowers are working through Porter, Hartford, and Arlington Townships.
- VBCRC ditching and drainage crews are working through the backlog of projects this week:
  - Ditching on Broadway in Arlington Township
  - Ditching on 26th Avenue in Covert Township
  - Pipe installation on the 86000 block of 67th Street and on 67th Avenue between CR 681 and 60th Street in Hartford Township
  - Pipe installation on Sonoma Way in Antwerp Township

### ENGINEERING

- Pavement markings are being placed as contractor availability allows. They are expected to wrap up in the coming weeks.

### MISCELLANEOUS

- VBCRC tree crews are in Almena Township on 24th Avenue and on CR 687 South of CR 388 in Geneva Township.

- Crews are preparing equipment for the winter season.
