VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE FOR THE WEEK OF AUGUST 25

OPERATIONS

- · Fog seal continues this week.
 Locations are posted on our social media channels with our sealcoat operations. New in 2025, roads will be closed to traffic for the duration of the fog seal emulsion drying, flaggers will be utilized in specific locations.
 Traffic should expect travel speeds to not exceed 5 MPH while the emulsion is wet.
- The second round of roadside mowing continues in Paw Paw, Keeler, and Pine Grove Townships.
- VBCRC tree crews are completing storm clean ups county-wide and started a tree job on CR 665 in Paw Paw Township.
- A ditching crew is working on local road projects in Covert Township.
- · Boom mowing is underway in Bangor and Porter Townships.
- Graders have started shaping gravel roads in Paw Paw and Arlington Townships.

ENGINEERING

- Bridge preventative maintenance continues on Baseline Road between 71.5 Street and 72nd Street in South Haven Township. The contractor is Nashville Construction Company.
- The painting contractor has started in Van Buren County on roads slated to receive lines this year, including roads that were repaved or received sealcoat and fog seal.
- The mill and pave on CR 388 between the City of Gobles and the Village of Bloomingdale in Bloomingdale Township is expected to start after Labor Day.
- Trestle Creek subdivision in Almena Township will be milled next week with paving to follow.
- · CR 384 between CR 681 and CR 687 in Geneva Township will be closed to through traffic starting Friday for drainage improvements. Milling the existing asphalt and repaving will follow the culvert replacements.
