### MAINTENANCE

#### *Operations Update*

- Fog seal and sealcoat operations will continue next week, pending materials and weather. Daily updates are posted on all of our social media channels.
- Asphalt patching continues countywide in preparation for winter.
- Boom mowing wraps up countywide with final touches in Covert and Paw Paw Townships.
- Miscellaneous ditching, storm clean-up, tree trimming and removals to occur as time and weather allow.

### MISCELLANEOUS

#### *Update*

- The Township Annual Meeting is scheduled for October 26th from 6 to 8 PM and on October 27th from 3 to 5 PM at the Van Buren Conference Center in Lawrence. Planning forms, PASER Ratings, and more details have been sent to Township Boards.

### ENGINEERING

#### *Update*

- CR 388 from the Village of Bloomingdale to CR 384 began August 23rd and has an expected completion date of October 15th. The project will be a total reconstruction of the roadbase. The contractor is currently working on drainage corrections and ditching.
- 64th Avenue from 30th Street to CR 657 will begin at the end of the week with preparing the road to be pulverized and paved. The expected completion date is October 6th, pending weather.
- The following projects will be completed by October 29th:
  - CR 215; CR 384 to CR 388 in Columbia Township: crush, shape, pave
  - CR 689; M-43 to 8th Ave in South Haven Township: mill and fill
  - CR 652; Red Arrow Highway to CR 375 in Antwerp and Alma Townships: mill and fill
  - CR 652; Red Arrow Highway to French Ave in Antwerp Township: mill and fill
  - CR 657; Red Arrow Highway to CR 358 in Antwerp Township: mill and fill
