OPERATIONS

- Contract gravel continues this week in Geneva and Bloomingdale Townships.
- De-berming continues in Decatur Township and will move to Arlington Township next.
- Boom mowing continues on local roads in South Haven and Bangor Townships.

- Ditching and drainage work continues across the county with projects in Keeler and South Haven Townships.

ENGINEERING

- CR 352 between CR 687 and 60th Street in Keeler Township continues this week with concrete work and paint lines.
- CR 687 between 90th Avenue and CR 342 in Keeler Township is complete and open to all traffic.
- 26th Street between CR 358 and 66th Avenue in Antwerp Township is complete and open to all traffic.
- 26th Street between Red Arrow Highway and the Village of Mattawan in Antwerp Township continues this week with paving, weather permitting.
- Red Arrow Highway between CR 671 S and the Village of Lawrence in Lawrence and Paw Paw Townships starts this week with milling the existing asphalt. The road will remain open under the guidance of flaggers.
- Autumn Vineyards Subdivision in Antwerp Township begins this week with curb and gutter work. The subdivision will also be milled and repaved following the completion of the curbs and gutter.
