OPERATIONS

- Tree trimming on plow routes is scheduled to occur as weather allows. This trimming ensures visibility for motorists as well as allows drivers to learn their routes for the new season.
- Extra width mowing on the primary road system continues in Paw Paw Township.
- Graders and trucks with carbide scraper blades will be out preparing gravel roads for winter!

- Two gradall crews will be running this week to complete ditching and drainage projects before winter. This week's schedule includes drainage improvements in Arlington, Bangor, and Lawrence Townships.

ENGINEERING

- 80th Avenue between M-40 and 29th Street in Porter Township will have shoulders placed this week, beginning the 24th.
- CR 388 between 29th Street and CR 653 S in Pine Grove Township continues with curb placement and shaping this week. Paving is expected to occur this week, weather permitting. The scope of the project is a complete reconstruction.
- CR 689 between 8th Avenue and CR 388 in South Haven Township continues this week with placing concrete curbs. The scope of the project is a complete reconstruction.
- The pavement marking contractor is out placing pavement markings as weather allows.
