

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF APRIL 15

OPERATIONS

- Asphalt plants have reopened for the season so VBCRC crews are focusing on patching county-wide. Total patchers are focused on primary roads – currently in Keeler and Covert Townships.
- VBCRC tree crews are working in the 23000 block of 29th street in Pine Grove Township. Next up is Antwerp Township- 72nd Avenue from the Village Limit East.
- The Drainage crew is replacing a pipe in Geneva Township on CR 384 between CR 687 and 68th Street. Next up- replacing failing pipes in South Haven Township at 08251 CR 687 and Bangor Township at 70th Street North of 38th Avenue.
- Boom mowing in Arlington and Columbia Townships will wrap up this week.
- Crews have been cleaning the curb area of 38th Street and Red Arrow Highway (horseshoe area by Refresco/Coca-Cola) and along Blue Star Highway as time/manpower allows.

ENGINEERING

- Clearing and drainage work in preparation of paving Howard Drive in Lawrence Township is scheduled to begin the week of April 15th and is expected to be completed by May 31st.
- CR 360 between 55th Street and CR 215 in Hamilton Township will be closed to through traffic beginning the week of April 15th for a culvert replacement. This project is expected to be completed by April 26th. The detour route follows CR 215, CR 365, and CR 681. For more information, please visit our website vbcrc.org/projects.
