# **Van Buren County Board of Road Commissioners**

January 12, 2023 - Regular Meeting

BE IT REMEMBERED: That on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2023 at 5:00 PM, E.D.T., the Board of County Road Commissioners for the County of Van Buren met in regular session at the Road Commission Administrative Office in Lawrence, Michigan.

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM.

The Chairman opened the meeting to first public comment. Richard Gerdy of 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Hartford Township states he regularly runs on 48<sup>th</sup> Avenue which was chip sealed some time ago and is "smooth and silent" while the new "experimental chip seal" on 68<sup>th</sup> Street is "very noisy". Mr. Gerdy wanted it noted that he would not want this "new chip seal" in front of his house and to "be careful about this experiment". The Board thanked him for voicing his concerns.

County Commissioner Doroh advised that the Board of Commissioners has selected Randy Peat as Chairman of the Board, and Paul Schincariol as Vice-Chairman of the Board.

Managing Director Bishop presented Staff Reports as follows:

- 1. After the blizzard (Christmas) we pushed back the snow as much as possible to keep the snow and resulting melt out of the roads. Many residents have called and complained we "turfed" their yards. We informed them of our purpose and reassured them we would inspect the roadside areas this spring, as we normally do. We also reminded them we have 33 feet from the center of the road as our right of way to operate in.
- 2. The County Board of Commissioners did approve ARPA funding in the amount of \$1.2 million for the CR388 project in Pine Grove Township. I did inform the Township Supervisor of this commitment.
- 3. Our PASER Road Rating training starts in February. I plan on keeping my certification intact to use here at the Road Commission.

- 4. A reminder, the SW Council meeting is Feb 13. If you wish to attend please let Jill know ASAP.
- 5. Barry attended the Pine Grove Township meeting and answered questions regarding the CR388 project. There were several questions about the removal of trees. Barry explained that since federal funds were involved the trees needed to be removed per federal regulations.

Bishop provided a radio communication update for the Board. The provider, Horizon Broadband, canceled services on Monday to be effective immediately. We are working now to find short-term communication services.

Managing Director Bishop presented a Resolution received from Geneva Township monetarily supporting a mill and pave project on CR384 from 70<sup>th</sup> Street to CR687 in the amount of \$150,000.00. Chairman Nelson provided an update for the Board and those present regarding the hiring of the new Managing Director. Once the negotiated Employment Contract has been approved by the Road Commission's attorney and Bret Witkowski's attorney, Mr. Witkowski intends to begin employment on a part-time basis, as available with full time employment to commence on March 6<sup>th</sup>. The Finance and HR Director, Linnea Rader, will serve as "Acting Managing Director" during the interim period of Bishop's retirement departure and Witkowski's arrival as full time Managing Director. Nelson anticipated that the Employment Contract would be ready for consideration by the Board at its next regular meeting.

#### **RESOLUTION 2023-01**

**WHEREAS**: Public Act 51 of 1951, as amended, provides that the Michigan Department of Transportation shall jointly, with the Board of County Road Commissioners, ascertain and fix the total mileage of County Primary Roads and the total mileage of County Local Roads in each county of the state which have been taken over as County Primary and County Local Roads; and,

**WHEREAS**: In complying with the provisions of said Act, the Michigan Department of Transportation has requested that this Board certify the mileage and location of such roads required by said Act to be fixed and ascertained.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**: That the Board of County Road Commissioners of the County of Van Buren, Michigan, does hereby certify that all of the roads on which lengths have been entered along the road bands of the attached township and enlarged section maps are normally open to automobile traffic during the months of May through October, and are under the jurisdiction of the Van Buren County Road Commission as follows:

RESOLUTION ADOPTED.

Anttila provided discussion for the Board about a request received for a LED traffic sign. These signs are relatively new and while they are compliant with the Michigan Manual for Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MMUTCD) and, therefore, allowed under current Road Commission Policy, they are costly to install and subject to routine maintenance as well as failures/breakdowns. Anttila stressed the importance of using sound engineering judgment should the Board decide to approve the use of LED traffic signs. Review of crash history, uniformity, driver behavior, etc. was discussed, as well as the cost of installation, replacement and maintenance. The Board requested that the matter be brought back to them at a later date for further consideration. Meanwhile, staff will research any possible ongoing studies surrounding LED sign installations.
