MAINTENANCE

Operations Update

- Roadside mowing continues in Columbia, Keeler, Antwerp, and Paw Paw Townships. It has been completed in Arlington, South Haven, Geneva, and Hamilton Townships.
- Hotmix asphalt patching is occurring on primary and local roads countywide in preparation for sealcoat.
- Dust control will occur this week in Decatur, Columbia, Keeler, and Bangor Townships.
- Contract Gravel has been completed in Columbia and Decatur Townships and continues in Paw Paw, Waverly, and Bangor Townships.
- Sealcoat is anticipated to begin in Hartford Township on June 14th, pending weather.
- Miscellaneous ditching and pipe replacements continue countywide.

ENGINEERING

Update

- 30th Street between 48th Avenue and CR 653 in Almena Township finished base paving last week. Top course paving and shoulders are expected to be completed by the end of the month.
- CR 374 from Red Arrow Highway to 45th Street in Lawrence and Paw Paw Townships continues with drainage corrections and widening.
- HMA Overlay is scheduled to begin in June in Antwerp Township for Rose Meadow/Primrose Path and Rosemary Lane.
- Work on 64th Avenue from 30th Street to CR 657 is expected to begin with tree work on June 21st. The project consists of tree removals, crushing and shaping the roadbed, a 4" HMA base pave, and a top course pave.
- CR 380 from the Village of Breedsville to the Bloomingdale Township line has completed the base paving. Shoulders will be placed as soon as weather allows.
