

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 1

OPERATIONS

- Fog seal wraps up the week in Covert and Paw Paw Townships. Locations are posted on our social media channels with our sealcoat operations. **New in 2025, roads will be closed to traffic for the duration of the fog seal emulsion drying, flaggers will be utilized in specific locations. Traffic should expect travel speeds to not exceed 5 MPH while the emulsion is wet.**
- The second round of roadside mowing continues in Paw Paw, Bangor, Hamilton, and Pine Grove Townships.
- Boom mowing continues in Bangor and Porter Townships.
- The gradall crew has been working on ditching projects in Covert and Porter Townships this week.
- Tree work continues on CR 378 in Bangor Township.

ENGINEERING

- Bridge preventative maintenance continues on Baseline Road between 71.5 Street and 72nd Street in South Haven Township. The contractor is Nashville Construction Company.
- The painting contractor is continuing on roads scheduled to receive lines this year, including roads that were repaved or received sealcoat and fog seal.
- The mill and pave on CR 388 between the City of Gobles and the Village of Bloomingdale in Bloomingdale Township is expected to start the week of September 15th.
- CR 384 between CR 681 and CR 687 in Geneva Township continues this week with drainage improvements. Milling the existing asphalt and repaving will follow the culvert replacements.
- Trestle Creek Subdivision in Almena Township is scheduled to be milled and paved next week.
- Vintage Point, Fox Creek Farms, and Birmingham Meadows Subdivisions in Antwerp Township started this week, all will be milled this week with paving to be wrapped up next week.
