- Due to mechanical issues and large amounts of storm damage, sealcoat will be on hold from June 23rd through July 8th.
- Storm clean-up, washout repair, miscellaneous ditching, and pipe replacements continue countywide.

- Due to the massive amount of rain, washouts, and erosion repairs are being made to 30th Street between 48th Avenue and CR 653 in Almena Township.
- Rose Meadow/Primrose Path and Rosemary Lane in Antwerp Township have received the poured curbs and driveways will be poured as weather allows.
- CR 380 from the Village of Breedsville to the Bloomingdale Township line is open to the traveling public, final paint markings are pending contractor availability.
- 18th Avenue from the County Line to the County Drain in Pine Grove Township is being crushed June 29th with shaping to follow, as weather allows.
