

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 5

OPERATIONS

- VBCRC crews are focusing on scraping gravel roads across the county.
- Crews are patching potholes county-wide.
- Boom mowing will continue on the local and primary road systems this week.
- Crews are fixing washouts in South Haven and Covert Townships.
- Stump removals continue on CR 215 between 44th Avenue and 48th Avenue in Arlington Township. This is in preparation of a safety project to occur in 2024.
- Bids for Blue Star Highway Mowing, Liquid Dustlayer, and Contract Gravel were opened on February 6th. These prices will be sent to Townships following Board approval of the bids.

ENGINEERING

- CR 689 between 8th Avenue and CR 388 in South Haven Township will continue as weather allows with utility contractors moving lines and contractors installing guardrails.
- VBCRC Engineers are preparing estimates and bid packets for 2024 projects. Bid opportunities can be found at vbcrc.org/bids
