MAINTENANCE

Operations Update

- Road maintenance employees are working through tree trimming/removal requests and pothole patching requests, as weather allows.
- Segments of roads for gravel and sealcoat are due as soon as possible, so the roads can be properly prepared and scheduled.
- As a reminder, 2021 Road Planning Forms should have been returned by December 31st, 2020. We are still missing forms from the following township(s): Bangor, Porter.

- Annual Spring shaping and compacting of the gravel roads system continues in Paw Paw, Hartford, Keeler, and Bloomingdale Townships this week, as weather allows.
- De-berming CR 687 from City of Hartford to 90th Avenue West and CR 380 from Blue Star Highway to Village of Breedsville, as weather allows.

ENGINEERING

Update

- 30th Street between 48th Avenue and CR 653 in Alma Township: construction continues with drainage corrections, trenching, and widening.
- Tree removal on Burgess Road from 82nd Avenue to 38th Street in Decatur Township began March 15th. The Southside of the road has been completed and the contractor will continue on the Northside of the road when utilities have been moved.
- CR 380 from Breedsville Village Limits to the Bloomingdale Township Line in Columbia Township has resumed with touchups and restoration.
- CR 374 from Red Arrow Highway to 45th Street in Lawrence and Paw Paw Townships will continue April 19th, weather permitting.
