

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF APRIL 8

OPERATIONS

- Asphalt plants have reopened for the season so VBCRC crews are focusing on patching county-wide. Total patchers are focused on primary roads in Bloomingdale and Paw Paw Townships.
- The crew on 30th Avenue between 75th and 76th Streets in Covert Township is wrapping up pipe installations and should complete the project this week.
- Graders are in Lawrence and Columbia Townships and will work their way around the county shaping gravels; trucks will intermittently be used to scrape problem areas.
- VBCRC tree crews will move to the 23000 block of 29th Street in Pine Grove Township following completion of tree work on CR 388.
- Ditching and crosspipe replacements are scheduled to occur in Covert, Geneva, and South Haven Townships pending clearance from MISS DIG.

ENGINEERING

- Progress on CR 689 between 8th Avenue and CR 388 in South Haven Township will continue as contractor availability allows.
- VBCRC crews are removing trees on CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township in preparation of a larger project to occur this construction season. More information can be found at vbcrc.org/bidtabulations.
- Clearing and drainage work in preparation of paving Howard Drive in Lawrence Township is scheduled to begin Monday, April 15th and is expected to be completed by May 31st.
- CR 360 between 55th Street and CR 215 in Hamilton Township will be closed to through traffic beginning April 15th for a culvert replacement. This project is expected to be completed by April 26th. The detour route follows CR 215, CR 365, and CR 681. For more information, please visit our website vbcrc.org/projects.
