

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 3

OPERATIONS

- The second round of roadside mowing continues in Bangor and South Haven Townships.
- Boom mowing continues in Covert and Hartford Townships.
- Gravel road grading is nearing completion in preparation of winter weather.
- Crews are preparing for plowing season by patching potholes and addressing shoulders along their plow routes.
- Trucks are being greased and prepared for snow plowing season!
- The ROW is staked for tree and drainage work to be completed in Geneva Township. Letters were sent to the residents to notify them of upcoming work. The roads affected are 65th Street between CR 380 and CR 384, 60th Street and 63rd Street both between CR 380 and 16th Avenue.

ENGINEERING

- Bridge preventative maintenance continues on CR 215 in Hamilton Township. Maintenance on the 13th Avenue bridge in South Haven Township and on the CR 665 bridge in Waverly Township.
- The painting contractor continues painting lines and lane symbols.
- The CR 665 bridge remains closed to through traffic until a re-fabricated guardrail is installed.
- Cider Court in South Haven Township continues this week with top course paving.
