- The mill and pave on CR 388 between the City of Gobles and the Village of Bloomingdale in Bloomingdale Township is expected to start the week of September 15th.
- · CR 384 between CR 681 and CR 687 in Geneva Township continues this week with drainage improvements. Milling the existing asphalt and repaving is expected to start the week of September 22nd.
