MAINTENANCE

Operations Update

- Primary roads will begin being sealcoated at the end of the month. Daily updates for sealcoat are posted on all of our social media channels.
- The second round of mowing continues in Arlington and Paw Paw Townships.
- Porter, Hartford, and Hamilton Townships will receive the second round of dust control this week. Geneva Township will receive dust control on roads that received gravel after dust control was applied in the spring.
- Miscellaneous ditching, storm clean-up, tree trimming and removals to occur as time and weather allow.

- CR 388 from the Village of Bloomingdale to CR 384 is expected to begin in early September and has an expected completion date of October 15th. The project will be a total reconstruction of the roadbase.
- Several projects have been let for bid. The bids will be opened on August 30th at 11 AM and will be awarded at the board meeting on September 1st.
