

# VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

## FOR THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 11

### OPERATIONS

- The third round of roadside mowing continues in Paw Paw and Covert Townships with Antwerp and South Haven Townships up next.
- Graders continue in Paw Paw, Waverly, and Columbia Townships, leaving Bangor and Geneva Townships left to wrap up the season!
- Crews are prepping for winter by patching potholes, trimming trees, and placing shoulder gravel along their plow routes.
- Boom mowers are on track to be completely done next week, they are working through Bangor, Geneva, and Hartford Townships this week.
- VBCRC ditching and drainage crews are working to complete the last of the patching from pipe replacements before asphalt plants close. Crews are expected to finish in the next day or two.
- Total patchers are addressing primary roads in Columbia Township.

### ENGINEERING

- Pavement markings are being placed as contractor availability allows. They are expected to wrap up in the coming weeks.

### MISCELLANEOUS
