OPERATIONS

- Roadside mowing has begun on both primary and local roads in Lawrence and Hartford Townships – VBCRC staff will be completing the mowing utilizing the new mowers received this year.
- Hot Mix Patching continues in between the rain drops! Crews have done a great job of covering a majority of Townships for maintenance patching and are mostly focusing on patching for sealcoat.
- Contract Gravel continues to be placed county-wide, focusing on Porter Township this week with Decatur Township up next.
- VBCRC crews are inspecting and replacing crosspipes on roads scheduled for sealcoat this year. Currently pipes are being replaced in Antwerp, Arlington, Bangor, and Porter Townships.

ENGINEERING

- Paving on Howard Drive in Lawrence Township is complete. Restoration is to follow.
- CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township is scheduled to begin next week. The project consists of crushing and shaping the existing asphalt surface, trenching and widening the road, completing drainage improvements, and repaving the surface. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
