

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF JULY 22

OPERATIONS

- Sealcoat is working its way through Paw Paw, Waverly, and Almena Townships this week. Daily locations are posted on our social media channels.
- The first round of roadside mowing is wrapping up in Antwerp Township and the second round of mowing began in Lawrence Township Monday.
- Washouts are being repaired county-wide.
- Dust control applications are expected in Bloomingdale, Bangor, and Waverly Townships next week.
- 29th Street between the Township line and 22nd Avenue in Pine Grove Township continues this week with stump removals, ditching, crosspipes, and driveway pipes.

MILLAGE FACTS

- The county-wide road millage only funds road improvements such as reconstruction/resurfacing and drainage improvements, not for routine maintenance such as pothole patching and snow plowing.

ENGINEERING

- CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township continues this week with drainage improvements. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- CR 380/20th Avenue between Ruggles Road and 76th Street in South Haven Township continues this week with drainage improvements. The detour route for this road follows Blue Star Highway, 14th Avenue, and M-140.
- 38th Street between Burgess Road and 72nd Avenue in Detour Township received the wedge pave is awaiting sealcoat and shoulders.
- 92nd Avenue between CR 669 and Porter Township in Decatur Township continues this week with drainage improvements.
- Traffic counts are being completed on paved roads in Antwerp, Almena, Waverly, Pine Grove, Paw Paw, and Bloomingdale Townships this summer.
