OPERATIONS

- Sealcoat continues in Paw Paw and Waverly Townships this week. Daily operations are posted on our social media channels, for the full list, please visit vbcrc.org/sealcoat.
- Fog seal continues this week in South Haven Township, moving East. Yard signs are placed along the roads receiving fog seal at least one day prior. Information is continually updated on our social media channels and at vbcrc.org/sealcoat.
- The second round of roadside mowing continues in Paw Paw and Porter Townships.
- A gradall crew is completing ditching and stump removals on Park Lane in Arlington Township.
- Roads are being prepped for double chip sealcoat applications in Geneva and Bangor Townships.
- A vacuum truck is working through sealcoated subdivisions this week.

ENGINEERING

- CR 653 between Red Arrow Highway and 48th Avenue project in Antwerp Township continues this week with traffic light timing.
- CR 365 between the Village of Lawrence and I-94 in Lawrence Township will be milled and repaved after Labor Day.
- 12th Avenue/Mill Lake Road in Bloomingdale Township will be milled and paved mid-September.
