OPERATIONS

- Fog seal is complete in Covert and Almena Townships, crews are working their way through the county with Blue Star Highway north of M-140 to be applied this week. Daily locations are posted on our social media channels.
- The second round of roadside mowing continues in Bloomingdale, Columbia, and Arlington Townships with Antwerp Township up next to complete this mowing cycle. Crews will be clearing downed trees and debris from the ROW during the third round of mowing.
- A drainage crew is replacing and installing pipes in Lawrence, Paw Paw, and Columbia Townships.

- CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township remains closed with guardrail installation expected to be completed next week. Pavement markings will follow the installation. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- CR 380/20th Avenue between Ruggles Road and 76th Street in South Haven Township is complete and open to traffic.
- Pavement markings are being laid as contractor availability allows.
