

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF MAY 8

OPERATIONS

- Patching continues countywide on both Primary and Local roads.
- Gravel roads are being graded in Geneva and Porter Townships.
- Crews are sweeping intersections in Antwerp and Geneva Townships before moving to South Haven Township.
- De-berming continues this week in Bloomingdale Township. De-berming is the process of removing sod, soil, and material that builds up along the shoulder of the roadway. De-berming assists in prolonging the life of a road by allowing water to drain from the road surface. It also helps various surface maintenance applications such as an asphalt overlay or sealcoat adhere to the road.

ENGINEERING

- CR 352 between CR 687 and 60th Street in Keeler Township continues with drainage work this week.
- Burgess Road between 38th Street and 82nd Avenue in Decatur Township paving is complete, shoulder work is scheduled to be completed this week.
- CR 687 between 90th Avenue and CR 342 in Keeler Township continues this week with stump removals.
- 30th Street between M-43 and CR 653 in Alma Township is on hold, pending permits and the site being dry enough for heavy equipment.
- CR 380 between CR 665 and Columbia Township Line in Bloomingdale Township received the top course asphalt last week. Shoulders are scheduled to be completed this week.
