FOR THE WEEK OF JULY 20

OPERATIONS

- Sealcoat continues in Covert, South Haven, and Geneva Townships this week while working East. Daily operations are posted on our social media channels, for the full list, please visit vbcrc.org/sealcoat.
- The second round of roadside mowing continues in Waverly, Bangor, and Hamilton Townships.
- The county-wide contract gravel program will wrap up for the season this week in Lawrence Township.
- Crews are ditching on 65th Street in Geneva Township this week.
- Patching continues in preparation of sealcoat as well as patching a crosspipe replacement on 72nd Street in Covert Township.

ENGINEERING

- The CR 653 between Red Arrow Highway and 48th Avenue project in Antwerp Township continues this week with drainage improvements. The full scope of the project includes trenching, widening, drainage improvements, crushing the existing asphalt, and repaving the road. The detour for this project follows Red Arrow Highway and 30th Street.
- CR 352 from CR 681 to 60th Street in Keeler Township is paved! The project continues with restoration, shoulder work, and pavement markings.
- A reconstruction project on CR 380 between 76th Street and M-140 in South Haven Township started this week. The full scope of the project includes trenching, widening, drainage improvements, crushing and repaving.
