### OPERATIONS

- Fog seal is expected to begin after Labor Day in Antwerp Township. Daily locations will be posted on our social media channels.

- Pipe replacements and drainage improvements continue county-wide with 40th Street in Waverly Township, Kable and 48th Avenue in Bangor Township, and 88th Avenue in Keeler Township on the schedule this week..

- Roadside mowing continues in the middle Townships of the county. The contractor is expected to wrap up in mid-September.

- Crews continue utilizing boom mowers to clear vision areas in Porter, Geneva, Bloomingdale, Pine Grove, and Lawrence Townships.

- Brush spray began on the primary system last week and operations are expected to be completed in mid-September.

- De-berming crews will be in Pine Grove, Covert and Porter Townships.

### ENGINEERING

- 30th Street between CR 653 and M-43 in Almena Township continues this week with ditching and drainage improvements.

- 16th Avenue between 60th Street and 62nd Street in Geneva Township will be paved next week, weather permitting.
