- De-berming continues this week in Almena Township. De-berming is the process of removing sod, soil, and material that builds up along the shoulder of the roadway. De-berming assists in prolonging the life of a road by allowing water to drain from the road surface. It also helps various surface maintenance applications such as an asphalt overlay or sealcoat adhere to the road
