### ENGINEERING

- CR 388 between 29th Street and CR 653 S in Pine Grove Township restoration continues this week, including reinstalling mailboxes and permanent signs. Pavement markings are scheduled for the next break in weather.
- CR 689 between 8th Avenue and CR 388 in South Haven Township continues this week with finalizing seeding and installing permanent signs. Guardrails will be placed when utility work is complete.



### DRIVEWAY STAKES

Stakes are a great tool in the winter to help drivers find their driveway. However, many times these are placed too close to the road that they become damaged by plows.

Our drivers are trained to plow into the road right-of-way to keep the road from becoming too narrow as the snow accumulates throughout the winter. To prevent your stakes from being broken by the plows, place them out of the right-of-way.
