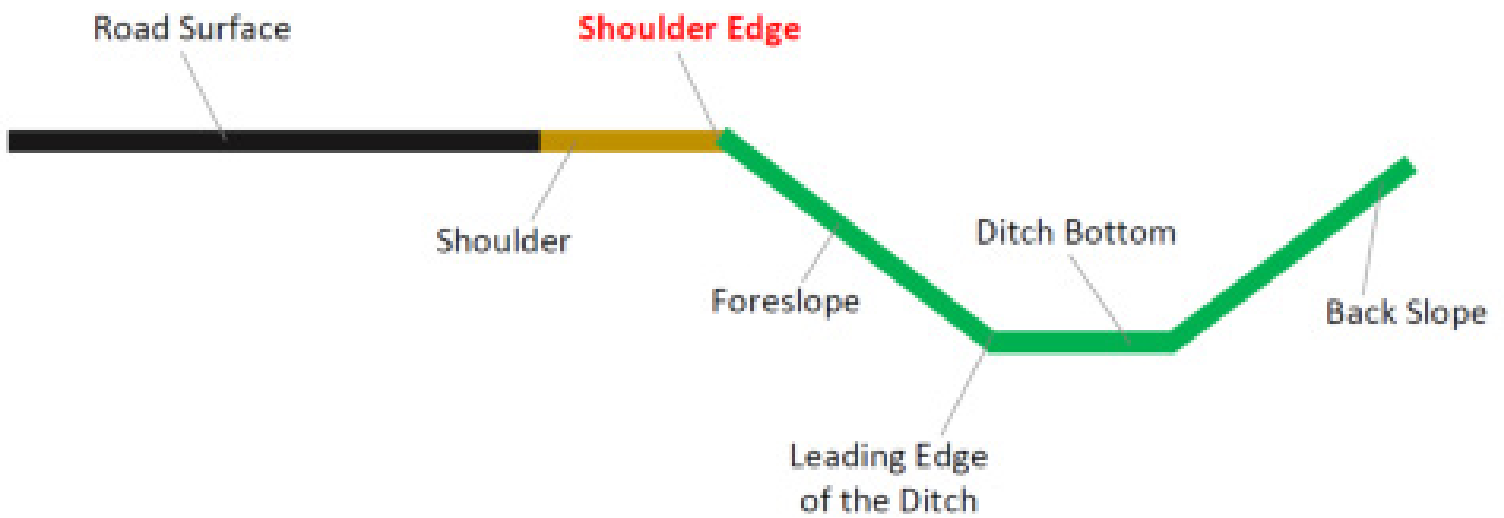


VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

OPERATIONS

- Boom mowing continues on local roads in Geneva Township this week in preparation of the double chip seal projects.
- Gravel road grading continues this week! All Townships will see at least a truck scraping or a grader, some Townships will have both. Gravel road maintenance is the primary focus of the week.
- The VBCRC wants to remind area farmers to keep the road right-of-way clear for public safety and maintenance purposes. Crops must be planted at least 14 feet from the road's edge of behind the back slope of the existing ditch, depicted below.
