OPERATIONS

- Fog seal is expected to wrap up this week! Locations are posted daily on our social media sites.
- Crews are preparing for winter! Wing plows have been added to all trucks with spinners to be installed next.
- Tree trimming on plow routes is scheduled to occur after fog seal. This trimming ensures visibility for motorists as well as allows drivers to learn their routes for the new season.
- Extra width mowing will finish in Arlington Township this week.
- Graders are out repairing washouts on gravel roads in Arlington, Lawrence, Porter, and Bangor Townships.
- The total patchers will be out to repair potholes during dry weather beginning on local roads in South Haven and Arlington Townships.

ENGINEERING

- 30th Street between CR 653 and M-43 in Almena Township is complete! Almena Township is hosting a "Grand Opening" of 30th Street on Monday, October 23rd at 6 PM on site.
- 80th Avenue between M-40 and 29th Street in Porter Township was paved last week and shoulders are expected to be placed this week, weather permitting.
- CR 388 between 29th Street and CR 653 S in Pine Grove Township continues with crushing and shaping this week. The scope of the project is a complete reconstruction.
- CR 689 between 8th Avenue and CR 388 in South Haven Township continues this week with crushing and shaping the existing surface. The scope of the project is a complete reconstruction.
- Paving and shoulders are complete on 16th Avenue between 62nd Street and 60th Street in Geneva Township. Up next: paint lines!
