

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF JULY 29

OPERATIONS

- Sealcoat is working its way through Porter and Antwerp Townships this week. Daily locations are posted on our social media channels.
- The first round of roadside mowing is expected to be completed this week and the second round of mowing began in Lawrence Township last week.
- Dust control applications are expected in Bloomingdale, Bangor, and Waverly Townships this week.
- The ditching and drainage project on 29th Street between the Township line and 22nd Avenue in Pine Grove Township is complete.
- Crews will be repairing washouts countywide this week.
- VBCRC crews are working through logged storm clean ups as time allows.

MILLAGE FACTS

- VBCRC has maintained and renewed the same millage since 1978.

ENGINEERING

- CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township continues this week with drainage improvements. Paving is scheduled for mid-August. The posted detour for this route follows CR 653 S, M-43, and 2nd Street in Kalamazoo County.
- CR 380/20th Avenue between Ruggles Road and 76th Street in South Haven Township continues this week with placing concrete curbs and other drainage improvements. Paving is scheduled for mid-August. The detour route for this road follows Blue Star Highway, 14th Avenue, and M-140.
- 38th Street between Burgess Road and 72nd Avenue in Detour Township received the wedge pave is awaiting sealcoat and shoulders.
- 92nd Avenue between CR 669 and Porter Township in Decatur Township continues this week with gravel shoulders.
