OPERATIONS

- Boom mowing continues on local roads in Bangor Township this week.
- Tree crews continue this week with storm clean ups, as well as the ongoing tree project on CR 378 in Covert Township.
- Flooded roads are being monitored and being reopened or barrels removed as we are able.
- Trimming around signs and pothole patching continues countywide as weather allows.
- Culvert replacements are scheduled to occur this week on 28th Avenue West of CR 665 in Waverly Township and on CR 380 South of CR 388 in Bloomingdale Township.

ENGINEERING

- Clearing on 73rd Street between M-43 and CR 388 in South Haven Township continues this week. This is in preparation of a larger project to occur next year.
- Clearing and constructing a turn-around on Silver Saddle Road in Columbia Township is continues this week.
- Tree and stump removals continue on CR 687 in Bangor and Hartford Townships this week.
- Bids have been opened for the CR 653 Federal Aid project in Antwerp Township. VBCRC crews have completed the tree work and construction will be scheduled as contractor availability allows.
