OPERATIONS

- Patching in preparation of the sealcoat season is underway!
- Boom mowing continues in Antwerp Township this week.
- Double chip sealcoat prep continues with ditching on 60th Street in Geneva Township.
- Roadside mowing continues in South Haven, Bloomingdale, and Porter Townships this week.
- De-berming in preparation of sealcoat continues this week in the Northern portion of the county.



ENGINEERING

- The CR 653 between Red Arrow Highway and 48th Avenue project in Antwerp Township is expected to begin the week of June 15th with signage being delivered next week. The detour for this project follows Red Arrow Highway and 30th Street.
- Two Antwerp Township projects, 25th Street from Red Arrow Highway to Mattawan and Ye Olde Woods Subdivision, received overlays this week. Restoration is to follow.
- CR 352 from CR 681 to 60th Street in Keeler Township continues this week with trenching, widening, and crushing the existing asphalt.
