### MAINTENANCE

#### *Operations Update*

- Remaining primary roads will begin being sealcoated at the end of the month. Daily updates for sealcoat are posted on all of our social media channels.
- The second round of mowing has been completed across the county.
- Extra width mowing continues in Arlington, Hamilton, and Decatur Townships.
- The third round of dust control for Almena, Paw Paw, and Bloomingdale Townships is scheduled for next week.
- Miscellaneous ditching, storm clean-up, tree trimming and removals to occur as time and weather allow.
