

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF DECEMBER 12

OPERATIONS

- Crews are trimming trees on the primary road system in Keeler Township.
- Gravel roads are being graded in Keeler, Columbia, and Waverly Townships.
- Tree crews are working on 38th Avenue in Arlington Township to remove tree stumps.
- Total patchers are patching potholes county-wide. Crews are also applying cold patch.
- The new guardrail de-bermer is working to remove the buildup of sod and grass under guardrails on the primary road system in Hartford Township before moving to Bangor Township.
- Roadside mowing is complete in Almena and Geneva Townships. Crews are moving into Waverly and South Haven Townships.
- Boom mowers are working on the primary road system in Arlington Township.

ENGINEERING

- Tree trimming and removal continues on 30th Street between M-43 and CR 653 in Almena Township, weather permitting.
