OPERATIONS

- Fog seal wraps up Tuesday in Bloomingdale Township!
- The second round of roadside mowing continues in Columbia Township.
- Crews will be clearing downed trees and debris from the ROW during the third round of mowing which is expected to begin after all mowers are serviced.
- Graders are treating gravel roads in Keeler and Pine Grove Township.
- Total patchers will be out this week in subdivisions across the county.
- Crews are trimming trees on their plow routes as staffing allows.
- Drainage crews are ditching in three locations in Geneva Township and will move to replacing pipes in Arlington and Bangor Township next.

ENGINEERING

- CR 388 between CR 653 S and the Kalamazoo County Line in Pine Grove Township is complete and open to all traffic!
- Pavement markings are being laid as contractor availability allows.

MISCELLANEOUS
