

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF APRIL 17

OPERATIONS

- Patching continues countywide on both Primary and Local roads.
- Gravel roads are being graded across the county.
- Crews are sweeping intersections in Lawrence Township and will work their way through the county.
- Crews are repairing shoulder drops county-wide.
- Primary de-berming continues this week in Hamilton and Decatur Townships. De-berming is the process of removing sod, soil, and material that builds up along the shoulder of the roadway. De-berming assists in prolonging the life of a road by allowing water to drain from the road surface. It also helps various surface maintenance applications such as an asphalt overlay or sealcoat adhere to the road.

NOTE: ALL operations tasks are dependant on current weather conditions, equipment availability, and staffing and are subject to change. For detailed information regarding operations tasks, please contact our office.
