### OPERATIONS

- VBCRC crews are focusing on patching potholes county-wide this week.
- Miscellaneous brush trimming around guardrails and bridge decks begins this week. This is a county-wide moving operation, please drive with caution in these areas.
- Boom mowing will continue on the local and primary road systems.
- Crews are fixing washouts in Geneva, Pine Grove, and Hamilton Townships.
- Stump removals continue on CR 215 between 44th Avenue and 48th Avenue in Arlington Township in preparation of a safety project to occur in 2024.

### ENGINEERING

- Progress on CR 689 between 8th Avenue and CR 388 in South Haven Township will continue as weather allows with utility contractors moving lines and contractors installing guardrails.
