

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF MARCH 4

OPERATIONS

- VBCRC utilizes two power brooms to sweep intersections each Spring. Lawrence and Arlington Townships are first up, followed by Hamilton and Bangor Townships.
- The crew on 30th Avenue between 75th and 76th Streets in Covert Townships has moved from ditching to installing crosspipes and driveway tubes.
- Boom mowers are still out on local and primary roads county-wide.
- Tree work continues on 20th Avenue/CR 380 between Ruggles Road and 76th Street in South Haven Township; removals are nearly complete. Crews will focus on trimming lower limbs and grinding stumps next.

ENGINEERING

- Progress on CR 689 between 8th Avenue and CR 388 in South Haven Township will continue as contractor availability allows.
- Bids for CR 384 in Geneva Township and 20th Avenue/CR 380 in South Haven Township will be opened on March 7th at 11AM. Bidding specifications and all bid opportunities can be found at vbcrc.org/bids
