

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

OPERATIONS

- Sealcoat continues in Geneva Township this week while working East. Daily operations are posted on our social media channels, for the full list, please visit vbcrc.org/sealcoat.
- Fog seal continues this week. Yard signs are placed along the roads receiving fog seal, starting in Lawrence Township and working southwest.
- The second round of roadside mowing continues in Waverly, Covert, and Hamilton Townships.
- Crews are ditching on 65th Street in Geneva Township this week.
- Patching continues in preparation of sealcoat as well as patching a crosspipe replacement on CR 388 in South Haven Township.

ENGINEERING

- CR 653 between Red Arrow Highway and 48th Avenue project in Antwerp Township continues this week with drainage improvements. Paving is expected to start next week.
- CR 352 from CR 681 to 60th Street in Keeler Township is complete!
- CR 380 between 76th Street and M-140 in South Haven Township continues this week with drainage improvements.

MISCELLANEOUS

- The VBCRC's Annual Report for the 2025 Fiscal Year is now available at vbcrc.org/annualreports. Linnea Rader, Finance and Human Resources Director, said, "In 2025, the Van Buren County Road Commission invested \$7.6 million in heavy maintenance and road and bridge improvement projects throughout the county. The agency also spent \$13.2 million on routine and special maintenance activities, including \$3.3 million dedicated to winter maintenance operations."
