

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

OPERATIONS

- Sealcoat continues in Paw Paw and Waverly Townships this week. Daily operations are posted on our social media channels, for the full list, please visit vbcrc.org/sealcoat.
- Fog seal continues this week in South Haven and Columbia Townships. Yard signs are placed along the roads receiving fog seal at least one day prior. Information is continually updated on our social media channels and at vbcrc.org/sealcoat.
- The second round of roadside mowing continues in Paw Paw, Antwerp, and Bloomingdale Townships.
- Boom mowing continues in Covert and Arlington Townships this week.
- A gradall crew is working through shoulder projects on 40th Street in Waverly Township and CR 365 in Lawrence Township and a crosspipe replacement on 72nd Avenue in Lawrence Township.
- Roads are being prepped for double chip sealcoat applications in Geneva and Bangor Townships.
- Storm clean up crews are working throughout the county.

ENGINEERING

- CR 653 between Red Arrow Highway and 48th Avenue in Antwerp Township is complete and open to traffic!
- CR 365 between the Village of Lawrence and I-94 in Lawrence Township started this week with a crosspipe replacement with milling and paving expected Friday and Saturday, respectfully.
- 12th Avenue/Mill Lake Road in Bloomingdale Township is expected to start Friday with milling the existing surface.
