

VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

FOR THE WEEK OF NOVEMBER 24

OPERATIONS

- Boom mowing continues in Covert, Porter, and Keeler Townships.
- Crews are grading gravel roads ahead of the rain and cold weather that is forecast for later in the week.
- Crews are addressing low hanging limbs in preparation of snow plowing. These limbs strike larger vehicles such as plow trucks and SUVs when coated in the heavy ice and snow we receive. Trimming these limbs now will ensure the VBCRC can safely plow through the winter.
- Tree work continues this week on 63rd and 65th Streets in Geneva Township.
