- The mill and pave on CR 388 between the City of Gobles and the Village of Bloomingdale in Bloomingdale Township started this week.
- · CR 384 between CR 681 and CR 687 in Geneva Township continues this week with drainage improvements. Milling the existing asphalt and repaving is expected to start next week.
- Trestle Creek Subdivision in Almena Township is scheduled to receive the final layer of asphalt this week.
- Paving in Fox Creek Farms in Antwerp Township is complete.
- The Birmingham Meadows Subdivision in Antwerp Township is paved with restoration to follow.
