

# VBCRC'S WEEKLY UPDATE

## FOR THE WEEK OF MARCH 16

### OPERATIONS

- The VBCRC is focused on snow and ice control Tuesday and Wednesday across the county.
- A tree crew is working on CR 378 between 70th Street and M-140 in Covert Township.
- Crews continue to patch potholes countywide this week.
- Trimming around guardrails continues this week.
- Crews are sweeping intersections across the county.
- Boom mowing continues on local roads in Pine Grove and Keeler Townships and on 65th Street in Geneva Township.
- Gravel road grading is currently on hold as ground frost remains. While recent warmth and expected rain will continue the thawing process, the roadbed must be fully thawed and dry to prevent further damage; gravel road maintenance will resume as soon as conditions allow.

- Project letters have been sent for tree work on CR 352 between CR 681 and Street in Keeler Township, on 73rd Street between M-43 and CR 388 in South Haven Township, and on Silver Saddle Road in Columbia Township.
