OPERATIONS

- Pipe replacements and drainage improvements continue at Kable and 48th Avenue in Bangor Township, 76th Avenue in Keeler Township, and 88th Avenue in Keeler Township.
- Equipment prep for winter operations has started! Trucks are being prepped with wing plow brackets this week.
- Boom mowing on the local road system is complete for the 2023 year.
- Due to rain delays for fog seal operations, crews are focusing on pre-sweeping the roads that will receive fog seal in Columbia, Genevea, and South Haven Townships.
- · Crews are beginning to trim around guardrails in Geneva, Bangor, Columbia, Waverly, Bloomingdale, Almena, and Pine Grove Townships.
- Sealcoat and de-berming equipment are being cleaned to be placed in storage for the winter.

ENGINEERING

- 30th Street between CR 653 and M-43 in Almena Township continues this week with paving. Paving is expected to be completed as weather allows.

- 80th Avenue between M-40 and 29th Street in Porter Township is expected to begin this week. The full scope of the project includes trenching, widening, drainage improvements, and paving.
- CR 388 between 29th Street and CR 653 S in Pine Grove Township is scheduled to be reconstructed beginning the week of September 18th.
