OPERATIONS

- After rain delays on Monday and Tuesday of this week, we plan to continue sealcoat on Wednesday and wrap up operations in Covert and Lawrence Townships. Locations will be posted daily on our social media channels.
- Storm clean up crews have been busy with downed trees from this week's wind and rain across the county.
- Pipe replacements and drainage improvements continue county-wide with Waverly Township up next on 40th Street.
- Crews are repairing washouts this week in Geneva and Covert Townships.
- Crews continue utilizing boom mowers to clear vision areas in Covert, Bloomingdale, and Hamilton Townships.
- Invasive species brush spray is scheduled to begin this month. The VBCRC partners with the Van Buren Conservation District to identify, target, and spray these invasive species.

ENGINEERING

- 30th Street between CR 653 and M-43 in Almena Township continues this week with ditching and drainage improvements.
- 16th Avenue between 60th Street and 62nd Street in Geneva Township will receive a crosspipe replacement this week with paving to follow next week.
